PARSONS, being duly sworn, deposes and says that he is the Chief Engineer of the State Highway Commission of Montana, and that the attached map, consisting of sheet 1 of Mont. 1-188(7), was prepared under his supervision from an accurate survey of the proposed highway and correctly represents the location and width thereof and shows in matching the Indian lands in all of the sections in the accompanying application; that under authority of Section 12-2004, Revised Codes of Montana, 1955, the applicant desires to secure from all owners of the various Indian lands affected, the right to control access facilities and service roads, including the rights of access, air, view and light in connection with the construction of said highway, which is a part of the Interstate Highway System.
